I am a tenure track researcher at Sapienza University of Rome and a Marie Skłodowska-Curie research fellow (2021-2024) with a project titled *Transnational Maghreb and the International Prize for Arabic Fiction: Pluralism, inclusiveness, and peaceful coexistence in the contemporary Maghrebi novel* — TRANSECT. I hold a PhD fully funded by Sapienza University of Rome, with a thesis on space and place in the oeuvre of the Jordanian writer and critic Ghalib Halasa (1932-1989).

Since 2015, I have carried out two smaller research projects: one about rap and protest music in the SWANA region in the aftermath of the 2011 uprisings, and one about nationalism and the novel in Jordan. Both projects have resulted in articles and conference presentations.

Between 2020 and 2021 I was research assistant at Sapienza University of Rome. I worked as a guest lecturer at the University of Macerata, where I taught courses in Arabic literature and culture and Arabic-to-Italian interpreting and translation (2019-2021).
